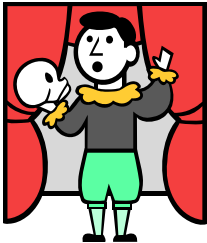


## Visual Arts Camp I - June 7-11 from 9 am – 12 pm

## Visual Arts Camp II - June 14-18 from 9 am – 12 pm

For children ages 9-13 taught by the City's Artist-in-Residence, Rob Maniscalco. Students will receive more in-depth instruction in visual art using various art media with an emphasis on portraiture. This will be a good opportunity to strengthen art portfolios for the more serious student while having fun! Students of all ability levels will benefit from the opportunity to be creative!



## Drama Camp I - June 21-25 from 9 am – 12 pm

For children ages 5-8 taught by Julian Gooding. Students will learn dynamic skills for acting in fun ways to build confidence and stage presence. The camp concludes with a free performance of Summer Children's Theatre at 10 a.m. on Friday, June 25 to see Mark Lippard's Juggling & Variety Show

## Drama Camp II - July 12-23 from 9 am – 12 pm

For children ages 9-13 taught by Julian Gooding. Students will have the opportunity to learn more intensive drama skills in a Performance Workshop format that will focus on a performance for the parents and the community at the end of the camp.

The fee for all camps is \$50 per week and students can pre-register early to get in the desired camp. A minimum number of registered students are required for the camps to take place.
