Narrative:

On 4/25/2022 at approximately 8:50 pm, I (Officer Besancon) was traveling on Palmetto Commerce when I heard approximately twenty rapid gun shots coming from the baseball field in Pepper Hill. I notified dispatch and responded to the area. When I arrived on scene I began speaking to witnesses and attempted to locate any victims. The witnesses stated that a large group of teenagers pulled into the parking lot in separate vehicles and began to fist fight with each other. The suspects then began shooting at each other. All of the subjects fled the area in their vehicles. Witnesses stated that it appeared that a [REDACTED] was driving and shooting at a [REDACTED] sedan. After securing the crime scene I then began to view surveillance video from the North Charleston baseball stand. [REDACTED] When I returned from viewing the video detectives were on scene and were interview a subject that had arrived in a white Toyota Highlander [REDACTED] Detectives and Officers were also conducting a search of that vehicle and a red Ford Focus [REDACTED] During the incident three vehicle were struck by gunfire, a silver Volkswagen Passat, a red Ford Focus, and grey Chevy Traverse. Narrative:

On April 26, 2022 Officers responded to [REDACTED] Vinewood Pl. in reference to shots being fired. Upon arrival Officers met with [REDACTED] who stated that a [REDACTED] was parked in his driveway that was unoccupied and running. [REDACTED] also stated that there was a black male on the side of his house with a weapon. [REDACTED] stated that he went back inside his house and retrieved his gun. When [REDACTED] returned the truck was occupied and a passenger was getting into the vehicle. There were [REDACTED] spent shell casings located in Williams driveway. Upon further investigation a bullet hole was located on the outside of [REDACTED] house. Officers went inside the house and found that the projectile went through the interior wall, through a closet door and lodged inside a box in the closet. The projectile was recovered and entered into evidence. There were [REDACTED] spent shell casings located on Brandywine near the residence. [REDACTED] stated that he only heard 5-6 shots. [REDACTED] The homeowner ([REDACTED]) at [REDACTED] Brandywine road called police around 0630 and advised that he found a gun in his back yard. I, PFC J. Stewart retrieved the gun on the ground behind the chain link fence at [REDACTED] Brandywine Rd. The address where the gun was found was [REDACTED] Kings Grant Ln. [REDACTED] stated that he called 911 when the original incident occurred. [REDACTED] then ran toward the businesses on Palmetto Commerce Pkwy. [REDACTED]
